Job Title: Bureau of Land Management Biological Science Technician

Job Description: "I lead and coordinate monitoring activities for threatened, endangered, and bureau sensitive species as well as habitat quality monitoring within BLM owned parcels in the West Eugene Wetlands. Other job duties include data management and reporting, as well as planning for restoration activities such as mowing, burning, weed treatments and planting/seeding projects."

Ways to Volunteer, Intern, Learn More, Etc: Contact your local BLM office to see if there are any volunteer opportunities in a field you're interested in. Getting involved with local groups such as the native plant society, Audubon society, mycology society is also a great way to meet folks and learn about various projects happening in your community.

Advice From the Professional: If you end up volunteering for an organization in a field you are interesting in going into, treat it like you would a job. Although you may not be getting paid volunteering is a great way to meet people, gain experience, and get good references for future job searches.

Average Salary: It will depend on your pay grade, but in Oregon the pay averages around \$44,800/year.
