Job Title: Forestry Technician with the Bureau of Land Management

Job Description: "My job has two pretty distinct sides to it. One of them is wetlands restoration, and the other is coordinating the Special Forest Products programs for the south half of the District."

Ways to Volunteer, Intern, Learn More, Etc: "If you are interested in working for the federal government, I can't recommend the Pathways Program highly enough."

Advice From the Professional: "If you are really invested in being a botanist or wildlife biologist, make sure you take all the classes you'll need to be able to qualify for that position. A lot of times you will need a specific amount of units to even be eligible for a position." Also, "Apply to tons of positions, you're going to get lots of rejections without even getting an interview."

Average Salary: \$37,000-\$54,000, all the pay in the government is very standardized and the salaries of most federal employees are public knowledge. So you can look up what almost any federal employee makes!
